

# **Lost Arrow Gun Dogs**

## **TRAINING AGREEMENT**

In delivering my dog(s) to Lost Arrow Gun Dogs, I agree that the Trainer is to undertake training, board, and care for that animal(s). A deposit of \$200 per dog is required in order to reserve a position in the training rotation. This deposit will be applied to the cost of the first month of training. Training costs are \$500 a month for Puppy Development or \$600 a month for formal training. A charge of \$15 a day will be incurred for dogs boarded with Lost Arrow Gun Dogs while not in training. Monthly payments for training and other incidental services are due at the beginning of each month. High quality feed (Loyall Performance) and training supplies will be provided by the Trainer. Any other expenses incurred, such as veterinarian bills, will be paid by the owner of the dog(s).

Dogs in training with Lost Arrow Gun Dogs are required to participate in the Trainer's healthcare program, including worming and immunization. The Trainer administers heartworm preventative, topical flea and tick preventative, and wormers on the first of each month. If heartworm preventatives, flea and tick preventatives, or wormers are not provided by the owner, the Trainer will administer the products used at the facility and bill the owner on the next billing cycle.

In order to allow dogs to perform to their fullest ability, Lost Arrow Gun Dogs recommends long-haired dogs be sheared during the summer months. This may be done by the owner or the owner's groomer prior to the dog's delivery. If a dog is in need of shearing, the Trainer will provide that service at a charge of \$25. Lost Arrow Gun Dogs reserves the right to shear the dog if necessary.

The owner warrants the dog is in good health, is free from communicable diseases, and has neither internal nor external parasites. The owner will provide Lost Arrow Gun Dogs with proof of all vaccinations when the dog is delivered to the Trainer. Owner is responsible for paying any health related expense while the dog is at the facility.

In case of an emergency, the Trainer is authorized to obtain a veterinarian's services, should the Trainer deem necessary. The Trainer may assume the owner desires surgical care if recommended by the veterinarian in an emergency or in the case of a life-threatening illness, unless previously specified by the owner.

I understand there are inherent risks associated with training bird dogs and I agree to hold harmless, release, and discharge Lost Arrow Gun Dogs, its owners, agents, employees, officers, representatives, assigns, and others acting on the Trainer's behalf from all claims, demands, causes of action, and legal liability for any economic or non-economic loss due to bodily injury, death, property damage, or any other incident resulting from the care and training of the animal, except in the event of willful and wanton negligence on the part of the Trainer.
